General Suggestions:

1. Please unload your goods from 7:00 am – 8:45 am in the area behind the Community Center, for the vendors and on the back street by the condos, for the park dealers.
2. Please move your car and park it behind the Dairy Queen.
They were gracious to us in letting us park there. The customers need close by parking, So please don't block the area near the sale.
3. Make your displays attractive and clean up your area after the show.
4. We would like you to sell antiques, collectables, household dishes and goods, coins, jewelry and furniture. Please, **NO** new plastic goods from China.
5. Each dealer is responsible for his or her sales tax, if it applies to your sales.
6. The Chamber of Commerce and The Antique Flea Market Staff are anxious to please You in anyway. Call Gloria, Manager at 455-6798 for any questions or problems during The show.
7. We welcome artists, craftspeople, families and business people to sell at our show. Please fill in the application at the checkout table.
8. Inside spaces may be reserved one or more months early, outside booths may be paid Ahead or on the day of the sale. **NO** refunds are due because of weather, with a major Storm exception. A receipt for your booth will always be issued.
Make checks to: **Port Isabel Chamber of Commerce.**
9. Inside tables are six feet with two chairs also assigned.
The dealers in the outside spaces provide their own table and chairs.
The space outside is about 10'x12'. **NO** outside space reservations, except in the **Gazebo** and **Shelter.**
10. Cars are not allowed to drive on the grass of the City Parks! Please unload at the curb And remove car to Dairy Queen Parking Area.
